## To Parents or relatives:

- 1.) All parents and relatives are encouraged to attend Al-anon meetings.
- 2.) Please familiarize yourself with the lodger's agreement that all residents sign.
- 3.) Please understand that if you are paying for your son, daughter, husband, or other relative that the sobriety/compliance deposit, and all housing fees are subject to forfeiture if the resident is discharged, fails a drug test, doesn't come home, or moves out without giving proper notice.
- 4.) Have a clear understanding as to the terms under which you are either lending or giving them money for housing. Money provided for housing should generally be classified in one of two ways, loans or gifts.
- 5.) Below are the conditions under which deposits are refunded
  - a. Completion of the minimum 90 day length of stay
  - b. 30 day notice of intent to move out is given on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month for departure the next month. Partial or mid-month notices are not considered proper notice.
  - c. A \$100.00 application fee, \$30.00 late fees, and \$65.00 laboratory drug test fees will be deducted from all deposit refunds.
